



HAVING TROUBLE PAYING YOUR MORTGAGE, RENT OR UTILITIES?

You may be eligible for temporary assistance.

Recently, Treasury provided funding to assist South Dakota residents with emergency housing assistance. If you have been financially impacted due to COVID-19, the SD CARES Housing Assistance Program (SDCHAP) may provide temporary mortgage, rent and/or utility assistance.

Assistance provided is not a loan and does not have to be paid back. Payment is made directly to the mortgage servicer, landlord or utility provider on the applicant's behalf. Funding amount is based on need.

Funds can be used to cover rent, rental arrears, utilities, utility arrears, mortgage payments and mortgage delinquency, from March 13, 2020 to present.

DO I QUALIFY?

- Be a renter or homeowner;
- Have income at or below 80% of AMI (Renters) or 100% of AMI (Homeowners) for your respective county;
- Be financially impacted – directly or indirectly – by Covid-19;
- Owe past due mortgage, rent or utilities or unable to pay current housing expenses
